# **Creative Needle Arts: Summer Term 2025**

This summer term focuses on sewing and embroidery techniques, building skills over multiple weeks with extended projects.

# **Required Materials List**

- Basic sewing kit (needles, pins, scissors, seam ripper)
- Embroidery hoops (6" and 4" suggested)
- Embroidery needles (assorted sizes)
- Embroidery floss (assorted colours)
- Cotton fabric squares (light colours, various sizes)
- Felt sheets (assorted colours)
- Buttons, beads, and sequins for embellishment
- Transfer paper or washable fabric markers
- Iron-on patches or fabric scraps for appliqué
- Small ruler and measuring tape
- Thread (various colours)
- Optional: Simple sewing machine

# Weekly Lesson Schedule – this may change slightly

## Week 1 Introduction to Hand Sewing

- Threading needles and tying knots
- Basic stitches: running stitch, backstitch
- Project: Begin hand-sewn fabric pouch cutting and marking
- Homework: Practice basic stitches on scrap fabric

#### **Week 2: Continuing Hand Sewing**

- Review basic stitches
- Introduction to seams and finishing
- Project: Continue fabric pouch assembly and seams
- Homework: Complete pouch construction

#### Week 3: Introduction to Embroidery

- Transferring designs
- Basic embroidery stitches: backstitch, straight stitch
- Project: Begin simple embroidery design
- Homework: Complete embroidery design

#### **Week 4 : Decorative Embroidery Stitches**

- Chain stitch, French knots, lazy daisy
- Colour selection and planning
- Project: Begin embroidery sampler

• Homework: Practice new embroidery stitches

# Week 5: Beginning Sashiko Project

- Introduction to Japanese running stitch technique
- Pattern marking and execution
- Project: Begin sashiko table mat design and marking
- Homework: Complete pattern marking

#### Week 6 : Completing Sashiko Project

- Continuing stitch technique
- Edge finishing methods
- Project: Complete sashiko table mat
- Homework: Finish any remaining stitching

#### Week 7: Introduction to Appliqué

- Cutting and preparing fabric shapes
- Attachment methods
- Project: Begin summer tote bag fabric preparation and planning
- Homework: Cut appliqué pieces

## **Week 8 : Tote Bag Construction**

- Basic bag construction
- Seam techniques
- Project: Continue tote bag assembly and stitching
- Homework: Complete basic bag construction

#### Week 9: Embellishing the Tote Bag

- Applying appliqué designs
- Adding embellishments (buttons, beads)
- Project: Complete embellished tote bag
- Homework: Add final details to bag

# **Week 10: Beginning Stuffed Creation**

- Pattern tracing and cutting
- Understanding seam allowances
- Project: Begin stuffed animal or pillow cutting and marking
- Homework: Complete cutting and marking

#### **Week 11: Continuing Stuffed Creation**

- Sewing curved seams
- Assembly techniques
- Project: Continue stuffed creation assembly and beginning stitching

• Homework: Continue stitching pieces together

# **Week 12: Completing Stuffed Creation**

- Stuffing techniques
- Closing seams invisibly
- Project: Complete stuffed animal or pillow
- Homework: Add final details and embellishments

# Week 13: Final Class and Summer Showcase

- Review of techniques learned
- Project troubleshooting and completion
- Virtual gallery of all summer projects
- Discussion and celebration of achievements
